Applying...

Apply for admissions into Bacone College by completing an application online at www.bacone.edu or submitting a paper form.

Submit the non-refundable \$25 application fee and the Office of Admissions will process your application.

The Office of Admissions will contact you regarding the necessary academic records necessary to be reviewed for admission.

Transcripts...

Make arrangements for your academic records to be mailed directly to the **Office of Admissions** at the address above.

First-time freshmen and college transfers with less than 30 credit hours must submit official transcripts for high school, GED, ACT or SAT I and any colleges attempted.

Transfer students with 30+ college credits must submit official college transcripts for **all** colleges attempted. Students applying for the Nursing or Radiography programs must also submit transcripts from high school, GED and ACT or SAT I.

Admittance...

Upon receipt of all official records, the Office of Admissions will review your file for admittance into Bacone College. Upon successful review, we will mail your Admittance Letter along with the Intent to Accept and Intent to Decline forms which allow you to confirm your plans of attendance. Upon receipt of your Letter of Intent and your enrollment deposit, we will forward your official file to the Financial Aid Office for processing.

Financial Aid...

Financial aid is a vital part of financing a student's education. Early planning can make the difference in the receipt of potential grants and scholarships. Please visit the Department of Education's website www.pin.ed.gov and request your and your parents PIN identification number to file the FAFSA online. In January, you will be eligible to file a FAFSA with the Department of Education. The most accurate way to apply is through www.fafsa.ed.gov. Applying online for the FAFSA will allow the government to process your application and submit your information to the colleges of your choice within 7-10 business days.

Once your Student Aid Report (SAR) information is received by our Financial Aid Office, they can begin to complete your financial aid file and prepare an Award Letter for you. Your Award Letter will list the grants, loans, work-study and scholarship dollars you are eligible to receive to assist with funding your education. For students and parents that do not qualify for assistance, we have partnered with Tuition Management Systems (TMS) to offer payment plans allowing you to extend college expenses.

Apply for Bacone College scholarships before March 1st and research online scholarships to assist with your cost of attending college.

Housing...

Once you have been admitted and the Financial Aid Office has completed your file, you need to apply for housing and prepare to embark on your residential experience. The Housing forms are available at www.bacone.edu under the forms@bacone.edu link. The forms are in PDF format and can be downloaded for completion. The forms should be submitted to the Housing Director along with the housing deposit to ensure proper assignment of housing.

Testing and Registration...

New students to Bacone College are required to take our Institutional Assessments prior to advisement by faculty. Currently, all freshmen (new and transfer) are required to take the ASSET, TABE and CAAP tests. The enrollment process is completed once the advisor sets your schedule and the enrollment form is submitted to the Registrar's Office to be entered into the computer.

Orientation...

The week prior to the start of classes, Bacone will host Orientation Week allowing new students to become acquainted with their new journey. Activities will help foster the relationships that will last a life time!
