

BACONE COLLEGE MERIT-BASED ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarships listed below may only be applied towards a student's tuition expenses as a main campus student enrolled full-time (minimum of 12 credit hours) in the fall and spring semesters. These scholarships aid students in meeting their college tuition expenses and are not cash awards. These awards cannot exceed a student's total college expenses. Students receiving at least a 50% tuition scholarship (3,950) must be residential students.

Initial application deadline for all scholarships is March 1 for the up-coming fall semester eligibility.

Bacone Scholars Society

Up to Full Tuition (\$7,900) for Fall and Spring Applied Toward Total Costs.

Initial Eligibility Requires Meeting Two of the Following Three Criteria:

- 1) A minimum ACT composite score of 24 or a minimum combined SAT I score of 1090
- 2) A high school GPA of at least 3.75
- 3) High school standing within the top 10% of graduating class

Renewable Each Year Up To Four Years Based on the Following Criteria:

- 1) Be a student in good standing
- 2) Maintain a full academic load of at least 12 credit hours per semester
- 3) Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.50
- 4) Actively served in some type of leadership/service role on campus

Members of the Bacone Scholars Society are expected to participate in various leadership roles on campus such as Student Government Association, The Baconian Newspaper, Campus Ambassador's, etc. Students will be eligible to participate in special classes, seminars and workshops.

Presidential Scholarships

Up To Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) of Fall and Spring Tuition Applied Toward Total Costs

Initial Eligibility Requires Meeting Two of the Following Three Criteria:

- 1) A minimum ACT composite score of 23 or a minimum combined SAT score of 1060
- 2) A high school GPA of at least 3.50
- 3) High school standing within the top 15% of graduating class

Renewable Each Year Up To Four Years Based on the Following Criteria:

- 1) Be a student in good standing
- 2) Maintain a full academic load of at least 12 credit hours per semester
- 3) Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.25

Success Scholarships

Awards Range From Up to Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) to Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) of Fall and Spring Tuition Applied Toward Total Costs

Initial Eligibility Requires Meeting the Following Two Criteria:

- 1) A minimum ACT composite score of 22 or a minimum combined SAT of 1020
- 2) A high school GPA of at least 2.50

Renewable Each Year Up To Four Years Based on the Following Criteria:

- 1) Be a student in good standing
- 2) Maintain a full academic load of at least 12 credit hours per semester
- 3) Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.00

The following academic programs offer specific, merit-based tuition scholarships for eligible students enrolled full-time in both Fall and Spring terms of an academic year.

Business, Health Sciences, Education, Criminal Justice, Art, Theatre and Journalism
