

Checklist for Financial Aid Applicants

- o A complete FAFSA. Bacone College's OPEID number is 003147. (all students)
- Complete, official admissions documents. High school transcripts or diplomas must show a graduation date. (all students)
- Complete, signed verification documents. Some verification documents must also be notarized. (selected students)
- Complete, official tax transcripts. (selected students)
- Documentation to resolve conflicting information on a FAFSA. (selected students)
- A signed, dated financial aid estimate. (students who receive federal aid)
- A current federal direct loan Master Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling. (students requesting federal loans)
- A current federal Parent PLUS application, Master Promissory Note, and Entrance Counseling. (parents requesting PLUS loans)
- o Proof of attendance in all courses. (all students)
- Appeal forms for low grades and/or low rates of completion. (selected students)
- A scholarship form signed and dated by a member of administration, the student, and a coach if applicable (all students who expect to receive institutional aid)

All Financial Aid paperwork MUST be completed before the Add/Drop date of each semester.

What is the financial aid process?

Before the academic year begins:

- Apply to Bacone College and submit high school diplomas, high school transcripts,
 GED certificates, or college transcripts as required
- Complete a FAFSA
- Submit any required verification, tax, or other documents *
- Sign and date an estimate for your financial aid

During each semester:

- o Attend all courses in which you are enrolled
- o Maintain a satisfactory GPA of 2.0 or better

Between semesters:

- Contact the financial aid office if there will be significant changes to your schedule (i.e. changing from 12 hours to 3 hours)
- * Please note that changes to a FAFSA during an academic year can result in extra documentation requirements.
